RRM CANADA DAILY BRIEF

Key findings:

- RRM Canada did not observe any significant indicators of foreign state-sponsored information manipulation in its monitoring of the broader Canadian digital information ecosystem during the period of September 03 to 06.
- RRM Canada assesses the majority of English and French-language content originated from recognizable Canadian news sites.
- On Sept 6, Chinese Communist Party media accounts on WeChat shared widely Chinese Amb. Cong Peiwu's comments that "a small number of people in Canada are hyping the so-called 1,000 days detention of the two Michaels."
 - Cong said that Minister Garneau's remarks that the two Michaels were held in arbitrary detention and subject to opaque judicial processes were a "gross interference in China's judicial sovereignty" and that China expresses "strong dissatisfaction and condemnation"
 - o Cong did not mention GE44, or any other political parties or candidates.

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On our radar

User engagement with French and English-language online media

- The majority of French and English-language stories shared on Facebook, Twitter and Reddit for September 03 to 06 originated from recognizable Canadian media outlets.
- The topics with the most user engagement for the reporting period include:
 - Reports on anti-vaccine protests in Ontario and Quebec by Global News, CTV News, La Presse and Le Journal de Montréal received considerable user interest.
 - According to data analytics tool Crowdtangle, Facebook groups and pages located in Canada such as groups for local affiliates
 of Global News and CTV News were responsible for driving engagement for these stories.
 - RRM Canada assesses it is likely domestic social media users who are engaging with the topic, not foreign actors.

User engagement with Sinophone online media

- Two of WeChat's most popular news accounts (*Guancha Syndicate* and the *Global Times*) shared widely comments made by Amb. Cong Peiwu that "a small number of people in Canada are hyping the so-called 1,000 days detention of the two Michaels."
 - Cong's comments in Chinese media did not identify the "small number", but later mentioned Minister Marc Marneau
 - Amb. Cong's comments were also published on the Embassy of the PRC in Canada WeChat account, but received comparatively less engagement (1.2K views). Cong's comments on Global Times and Guancha Syndicate received over 100K views each.
 - The Global Times and the Guancha Syndicate are the 1st and 7th most subscribed WeChat accounts.
 - Researchers of Chinese Communist Party media <u>have called</u> the Global Times and Guancha Syndicate part of a "new nationalist movement predicated on anti-Western sentiment"
- The *People's Daily* and *the China Daily* carried an article about Chinese MOFA spokesperson Wang Wenbin discussing whether the arrest of the two Michaels was "retaliation" for the arrest of Meng Wanzhou.
 - Wang said it was not retaliation, and that Canada was "hyping" the case of the two Michaels.
 - Wang <u>asked</u> for the safe return of Meng to China, and cited that over "15 million people signed a [Global Times] petition demanding Canada to release her"
 - Wang did not mention GE44, or any political party or candidate in his comments.
 - Both the People's Daily and the China Daily articles received considerable attention from users (over 100K views each).
 - The People's Daily and the China Daily are the 4th and 56th most subscribed accounts on WeChat.

- Some groups on Gettr were <u>active in mobilizing</u> others to take part in the September 4 anti-vaccine passport rally in Toronto, including
 the Himalaya Supervisory Organization, a political lobby group created by former Donald Trump advisor Steve Bannon, and funded by
 fugitive Chinese billionaire Miles Guo.
 - The Himalaya movement funds a network called "the New Federal State of China" with groups in the U.S., U.K., Australia and New Zealand. The groups frequently attend rallies that protest the Chinese government, or oppose the use of vaccines to treat Covid-19.
 - According to a <u>May 2021 report</u> from Graphika, Guo is the center of a "vast network of interrelated media" that "disseminates online disinformation" and is a "prolific producer" of claims of voter fraud during the U.S. 2020 election.
 - The rally attendees connected to Guo mostly chanted slogans to "take down the CCP" and did not appear to support a
 particular candidate or party.
- Group with supposed links to China's "united front" work invites WeChat users to a Vancouver East LPC campaign event
 - The Facebook page for the Vancouver Hong Kong Forum Society published screengrabs from a WeChat group with members of the Chinese Benevolent Association (CBA) of Vancouver chat that shows what is purported to be an offer of a free lunch to support a candidate who "cares about the issues of the Chinese people". The CBA message further encourages solidarity among Chinese voters as a counter to Indian voter solidarity.
 - The Vancouver Hong Kong Forum Society claims the offer for free lunch comes from a well-known group with links to China's <u>United Front Work Department</u>, a unit that seeks to influence elite individuals and organizations in China's favour.
 - A number of journalists have made similar claims about the group's connection to the United Front, including the South China Morning Posts' <u>Ian Young</u>, the National Post's <u>Tom Blackwell</u>, and <u>Alliance Canada HK</u>.
 - o The WeChat invitation from the well-known group <u>says</u> that "the Chinese community and Chinese people have long been neglected. This LPC candidate in Vancouver East is running for the first time. We the Chinese people need to show our voting power to politicians. Indian people already have huge influence. The Chinese people should also show solidarity." The group then invites WeChat users to "bring some friends" and there's "no need to pay"
 - Vancouver Hong Kong Forum Society believes this is an instance of "vote buying" and is "in violation of the Elections Act"
 - The Facebook post inspired a <u>heated debate</u> on the r/Vancouver Reddit board, with many users questioning if the offer constitutes vote buying, and whether the group's supposed links to the CCP constitute foreign interference.

User engagement with Russophone online media

• There were no high-engagement posts from Canadian Russian-language media outlets for the September 03-06 reporting period

- Topics of interest in global Russian-language media include:
 - o a Russian-based tabloid mocking the results of Ukrainian Pres Zelenskyi's visit to the U.S.
 - o Putin <u>announcing</u> a new tax regime for businesses in the Kuril Islands.
 - o A likely Russian grey site citing a U.S. poll about Biden's falling popularity.
 - o Belarussian media <u>reported</u> on Canadians protesting vaccine passports
 - o State-media outlet RIA Novosti <u>reported</u> on the LPC's chance of winning the most seats; the article received low engagement.
