RRM CANADA DAILY BRIEF

Key findings:

- RRM Canada did not observe any significant indicators of foreign state-sponsored information manipulation in its monitoring of the broader Canadian digital information ecosystem on September 13.
- RRM Canada assesses the majority of English and French-language content originated from recognizable Canadian news sites.
- Canadian WeChat news accounts continue to <u>share</u> a story originally published by the *Global Times* that Conservative Party leader Erin
 O'Toole "mentioned 31 times" in the party platform, and "almost wants to break relations with China" but received minimal
 engagement (avg. 550 page views).
- The Global Times published two articles about the Canadian government's direction for state-owned China Mobile to divest from a
 Canadian telecom company. The articles quoted a spokesperson from the Chinese embassy in Canada who says: "Some Canadian
 politicians have been maliciously speculating on China-related issues", that a "few political party leaders have made unwarranted attacks
 on China's human rights during the Leaders' debate" and "violently interfering in China's internal affairs." The articles received
 considerable user interest (over 200K page views).
- An alternative Russian-news site called the "Russian News Agency, of the Russian Public Movement" <u>shared a story</u> about a newly founded Canadian militia group that made its <u>introduction</u> on YouTube. The article received some engagement on Twitter (81 engagements).

On our radar

User engagement with French and English-language online media

- The majority of French and English-language stories shared on Facebook, Twitter and Reddit for September 13 originated from recognizable Canadian media outlets.
- Some notable topics of interest include:
 - Blaze Media, an alternative online news site founded by Glenn Beck, posted an article about a University of Western Ontario
 professor who claims she is being unduly coerced to receive a vaccine by her employer. The article received considerable
 attention from U.S.-based social media users, but little attention from Canadians (more than 15K engagements).

User engagement with Sinophone online media

- The most-viewed stories on WeChat for September 13 originated from a mix of recognizable Chinese-Canadian WeChat news accounts and CCP media outlets.
- The *Global Times* published <u>two articles</u> about the Canadian government's direction for state-owned China Mobile to divest from a Canadian telecom company.
 - o In one of the article's paragraph, the author discusses the events of GE44: "A spokesman for the Embassy said that recently, some Canadian politicians have been maliciously speculating on China-related issues, and a few political party leaders have also made unwarranted attacks on China's human rights and rule of law during the debate, violently interfering in China's internal affairs, which China resolutely opposes." The article received considerable user attention (nearly 200K combined views).
- WeChat news account Canada123 published a story that claims the Conservative Party of Canada is the only "party doesn't mention a
 word about anti-racism" in its platform.
 - The author says "anti-racism should be Chinese voters biggest consensus" and that is "in the best interest of Chinese-Canadians to vote for a party that upholds multi-culturalism and opposes racism." The article received some user engagement (3.6K page views).
- Canadian WeChat news accounts continue to share a story originally published by the *Global Times* that Conservative Party leader Erin O'Toole "mentioned 31 times" in the party platform, and "almost wants to break relations with China."
 - Posted by the Chinese-language Winnipeg Express, the <u>article</u> adds additional commentary, saying the Conservatives' platform
 "challenges the Chinese people's bottom line" and calls on "fellow countrymen" to reconsider their support for the
 Conservatives.
 - The article received only 580 views, considerably less than similar articles posted on this topic.

User engagement with Russophone online media

[APG]

- There were no high-engagement posts from Canadian Russian-language media outlets for the September 13 reporting period
- Topics of interest in global Russian-language media include:
 - o An alternative Russian-news language site called "Russian News Agency" of the "Russian Public Movement" shared a story about a newly founded Canadian militia group that made its introduction on YouTube. The article received some engagement on Twitter (81 engagements).
 - A Russian <u>media outlet</u> connected to the country's Ministry of Defense discussed historical evidence, trial proceedings, and current status of former SS officer and Canadian resident Helmut Oberlander.
 - o Ukrainian opposition media reported on possible plans for President Zelensky to visit the U.S. again to attend UNGA meetings
 - o Sputnik Armenia reported on remarks made by a Russian senator that it would defend Armenia's recognized borders as its own
