PCO Comment

- On May 23, 2023, the Right Honourable David Johnston, Independent Special Rapporteur on Foreign Interference, provided his interim report outlining recommendations on protecting and enhancing Canadians' faith in Canada's electoral system. The second phase of his mandate will include public hearings on the governance and policy issues identified to date, which are set to begin in summer 2023. You have tasked Mr. Johnston to complete his work, including the submission of a final report, by October 31, 2023.
- It can, at times, be difficult to distinguish between malicious foreign interference and legitimate foreign influence. Public Safety Canada (PS) and PCO are working to provide briefings to Members of Parliament, Senators, and their staff, with more information on the threats, and advice on what to do if they feel that they are subjects of foreign interference.
