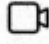

Here's the response we recommend your office send to Sam Cooper, in addition the planned RCMP response: 

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In January 2019, we developed our plan to protect Canada's democracy, which established a non-partisan panel to evaluate influence and interference.

The panel publicly announced their findings after both the 2019 and 2021 federal elections. They stated clearly that they did not detect foreign interference that threatened Canada's ability to have a free and fair election. CSIS emphasized their findings from the 2021 election at a recent meeting of the house affairs committee in Ottawa. At the committee hearing, the deputy director of operations at Canadian Security Intelligence Service testified that "We do see activity of foreign interference or attempts of trying to influence, but not enough to have met the threshold of impacting the overall electoral







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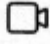
