






SECURITY AND INTELLIGENCE THREATS TO ELECTIONS (SITE) TASK FORCE

- Comprised of CSE, CSIS, RCMP, and GAC

 <u>Mission</u>: improve situational awareness of foreign threats to Canada's electoral processes and help Government assess and respond to threats







Coordination



A focal point in the security and intelligence community for Government partners

- Create awareness of activities, share relevant information
- Engage with domestic and international partners
- Where mandates allow, respond against threats
- <u>RCMP: both intel and enforcement at the table</u>









Role of Law Enforcement
