SUMMARY

•	On November 14, 2022, the House of Commons Standing
	Committee on Procedure and House Affairs (PROC), in the context
	of their current study on the topic of foreign interference, adopted a
	motion to order the production of documents in relation to the topic
	of potential Chinese interference in 2019 general election (Tab A).

- The motion recalled several previous witnesses to testify before the Committee, and called you. Your briefing package to support an appearance will be provided under separate cover once a final date has been determined by the Committee.
- In the meantime, the deadline for PCO to submit documents to the Committee was extended to Monday, December 12, 2022, to allow for classified documents to be appropriately redacted. The extension request is attached at **Tab B**.
- The Security and Intelligence and Intelligence Assessment Secretariats have identified documents for submission, attached under Tab C.
- Your review and signature is sought for the attached covering letter (Tab D) so that documents can be submitted to PROC. The Legislation and House Planning team is coordinating the document submission process on behalf of the Privy Council Office, and will deliver your letter and documents to PROC on your behalf.
