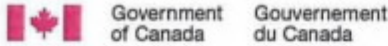

2023 Federal By-Elections

Threat Updates

GAC

- **(U)** RRM Canada did not observe any significant indicators of foreign state-sponsored information manipulation in its monitoring of the broader Canadian digital information ecosystem from 22-29 June 2023.
- **(U)** Only two English and no French language articles relating to the Calgary Heritage by-election were observed during this reporting period.

RCMP

- **(PROTECTED A)** The RCMP's Ideologically Motivated Criminal Intelligence Team (IMCIT) has not identified any direct threats to the by-election across social media, message boards, chatrooms, online forums or news media. As of 29 June 2023, all candidates maintain relatively low-profiles in online spaces and have yet to garner much attention across social media platforms. IMCIT continues to assess a low threat to the by-elections stemming from the ideologically motivated threat landscape.

- **(U)** No significant updates at this time.
