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Intelligence Dissemination and Tracking for Senior Leaders and Political Staff Initial Operating Capacity – September 11, 2023

By September 11, 2023, the new intelligence dissemination and tracking for senior leaders process will reach an initial operating capacity that will:

- Provide service to specific clients: This process will apply to the following Ministers (and staff) and Deputy Ministers (and Associates):
 - Prime Minister;
 - Minister of Foreign Affairs;
 - Minister of Public Safety, Democratic Institutions and Intergovernmental Affairs;
 - o Minister of Emergency Preparedness; and
 - Minister of National Defence.
- Capture all written intelligence products: This process will capture all classified products including classified reports, assessments, summaries and other formal intelligence reports produced by CSE, CSIS, ITAC, PCO IAS and CFINTCOM – going to the clients noted above.
- Include centralized dissemination: All reports from CSE, CSIS, ITAC and PCO IAS to the clients noted above will flow through Slingshot and will be delivered by Client Relations Officers (CROs) or SIGINT Dissemination Offices (SDOs). All reports from CFINTCOM will flow through the CFINTCOM digitized process.
- Service provided in the National Capital Region, but all intelligence provided to clients noted above to be captured: The tailored service (e.g. via CROs/SDOs) will initially apply the clients noted above are in the National Capital Region. However, all intelligence that is provided to a client noted above – even when provided outside the NCR – will be captured and recorded as part of this process.
- Tracking and reporting of dissemination and readership:
 - All CSE, CSIS, ITAC and PCO IAS reports will be tracked through Slingshot and CROs/SDOs. CSE will provide a [monthly?] report detailing all reports provided to/read by the clients noted above to the NSIA and DNSIA. It will also provide a monthly report on all reports provided to/read by each Minister/staff to the relevant Deputy Minister.
 - All CFINTCOM reports will be tracked through CFINCOM's digitized process. CFINTCOM will
 provide a monthly report detailing all intelligence provided to/read by the clients noted above
 to the NSIA and DNSIA. It will also provide a monthly report on all reports provided to/read by
 each Minister/staff to the relevant Deputy Minister.
- Selection of Intelligence for Dissemination:
 - As is currently the case, agencies which produce intelligence will continue to recommend reports to specific clients, and CROs/SDOs will continue to provide a regular selection of intelligence based on the needs and interests of their clients. Deputy Ministers, with the help of monthly reports may provide additional guidance/direction to departments and/or CROs/SDOs regarding the needs of their Minister
 - Deputy Ministers may direct the dissemination of specific pieces of intelligence to their Ministers/staff, and make recommendations regarding other Ministers. They may delegate this responsibility, so long as it provides clear and consistent accountability. DMCIR, the NSIA and DNSIA may direct that specific pieces of intelligence be provided to any Minister, staff or Deputy Minister.

In addition, by September 11:

- A CSIS SDO who will serve both Public Safety and PCO will be in place at Public Safety who will also serve PCO; and
- An SDO in CSIS' Atlantic Region will be identified to support Minister Leblanc outside the National Capital Region.

Service outside the National Capital Region

- Consideration could be given to broadening service beyond the NCR (above and beyond service to Minister LeBlanc)

Broader use of Slingshot

- Expanded client list and service delivery

- Once the process described above is up and running, consideration could be given to expanding the process to cover other Ministers and top-tier clients. Note that this would require additional resources for CSE

More integrated curation/tailoring of intelligence to clients

CSIS is contemplating broadening of SDO function

 In the longer term, work could be done to provide intelligence from all departments to a given top-tier client in a more integrated/curated manner.
