- (U) RRM Canada did not observe any significant indicators of foreign state-sponsored information manipulation in its monitoring of the broader Canadian digital information ecosystem during the period of May 16 to 24.
- (U) RRM Canada assesses the vast majority of content originated from recognizable Canadian news sites, and found no instances of foreign state-sponsored news outlets commenting on the by-election.
- (U) Overall, RRM Canada found little user engagement with news about the federal by-elections. Audiences in Western Canada are engaging with news items about the Alberta
