

The PRC's Many Tools of Transnational Repression – It's not Just Overseas Police Stations

For many years, the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) has used several vectors - [redacted] Overseas Police Stations - to target members of the global Chinese diaspora for the purpose of repression, influence and forced repatriation. The PRC targets overseas Chinese who have spoken out against the CCP. [redacted] This is sometimes achieved through transnational repression (TNR). Below are some of the tools used by the PRC government to conduct TNR. **This list is not exhaustive.**
