MEETING MINUTES

1. Welcome & Housekeeping

The Chair called the meeting to order and roundtable introductions were made.

2. SITE Meeting Minutes, December 13th

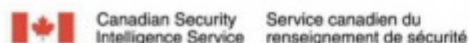
Minutes were approved for SITE Meeting, January 24th.

3. Durham by-election

The group shared observations further to the Durham by-elections on 2024 04 04. In the context of SITE TF monitoring of the by-election, as of 2024 03 05, the SITE TF had not

observed any indication of foreign interference, cyber incidents or violence directed at the by-election. The SITE TF deemed appropriate to extend monitoring a week past the by-election.

Elections Canada representative, [REDACTED], commented that EC successfully tested out electronic voting lists during the vote. No security incidents have been reported.

The group also discussed lessons learned out of an Election Canada (EC) led Table Top Exercise that took place on the date of the by-election at the RCMP HQ in Barrhaven. The goal of the TTX was to strengthen efficient intelligence communication in preparation for general federal elections. All SITE TF members attended the TTX, with EC, OCCE and several representatives from the law enforcement community. SITE participants agreed on the value of this efforts that permitted to better define roles and responsibilities, as well as to discuss respective tools. EC will follow up with a complete report on this initiative, to be shared with the SITE TF.

4. Tech Table

The reestablishment of the 'Tech Table', a group of technical experts from CSE, GAC, CSIS and potentially the RCMP, established to track and assess online FI threat activity and regularly meeting was discussed in the presence of SMEs who have been involved in this effort over the last federal elections. The group agreed on the value of this effort, especially in the context of the technological advancements in generative-AI, expected to enhance foreign electoral interference efforts which aim to control narratives, shape public opinion, and/or discredit factual information. The example of the recent Spamouflage Campaign provides an example of threat activity reported back to the SITE TF for further analysis. This initiative may be pursued under the banner of a 'SITE Incident Response Group' (SIRG), as opposed to the 'Tech Table'. It was mentioned that a scenario based meeting with additional SMEs participants would permit to discuss authorities, skills and resources.

- **Action item (SITE Chair):** this meeting will be organized after Easter with a larger group of SMEs from SITE agencies.

5. Review of ESCC Material

SITE Chair provided observations on the 'SITE 2024 By-Elections Framework' document. These observations were shared with PCO. It was further mentioned that this document would benefit to be made general, as opposed to specific to the Durham by-election. No further comments were shared.
