Thank you for the prompt follow up. I will keep you posted on our progress and coordinate efforts where possible.



Further to our discussion this week, I note that the Office of the Commissioner of Canada Elections (OCCE) has clearly identified a need to develop access to or in-house secure facilities. We are conducting a client assessment for our needs specifically as to the frequency of access needed, as well as turnaround time both during and outside an election.

As a first step to this process, would it be possible to ask to advise whether there are locations within where other government departments have infrastructure which we could leverage. This could provide either a short to medium term solution, or an alternative to installing our own infrastructure. In the event that there is no such infrastructure in walking distance, identifying such access on the event is important, to avoid potential delays when we need a rapid turnaround.

**Separately**, we would also appreciate more information on EC's efforts to leverage the Government of Canada Secret Infrastructure (GCSI) and how OCCE could be included in or served by that initiative. I know that been working with SSC to provide centralized Services in this regard.
