

The Commission can only examine complaints related to the Act or the Referendum Act. As a result, she cannot respond to complaints under laws that do not fall within her mandate or that are related to electoral legislation at other levels of government. In certain cases, the CCE may deal with an offence under the Criminal Code if it is closely related to an offence under the Act or the Referendum Act.







Consistency in interpretation notes

At the Commissioner must provide comments on draft written opinions and interpretation notes proposed by the Chief Electoral Officer.

Written opinions provide clarification on a specific area of the Act. They are issued to maintain consistency in its interpretation and application, as well as its enforcement. They may be issued by Elections Canada or at the request of the chief agent of a registered political entity. They relate to how the provisions in the Act apply to regulated political entities. They are published for informational purposes only and are not binding on regulated political entities.

Different areas of the Act and help make them more accessible to regulated political entities, in particular, they are found in guides published by the Commissioner for regulated political entities. Interpretation notes, guidelines provide practical advice on interpreting and applying the Act. Guidelines are not binding on regulated political entities.

Written opinions may be consulted by a candidate or party who wishes to undertake before a general election, and the Commissioner will publish a final version. Written opinions remain until such time as the contrary opinion is issued.


