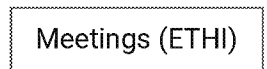
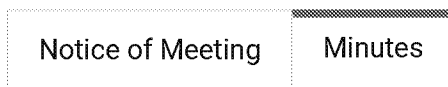
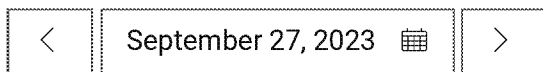


ETHI COMMITTEE MEETING
