


## PROC COMMITTEE MEETING

- (ii) the Honourable Steve MacKinnon, the Minister of State (House of Commons), by himself, for one hour, and
- (b) prioritize scheduling the appearances of Anthony Rota, Steve MacKinnon, and International and Interparliamentary Affairs officials.
