Social Media Monitoring Report: September 19, 5pm – September 20, 9pm, 2021

Observations principales / Key observations

- Volume: **Last 24h: 4.78K; Previous 7 days average: 2.25K posts/day; Previous 30 days average: 1.5K posts/day; pre-campaign average: 100 posts/day**
- Although those topics were not as popular as they had been in previous days, many users are still expressed distrust in vote by mail and the alleged use of DVS. Several users took to social media to share their concerns about not receiving their special ballot kits in time and were now wondering if they could still vote.
- Issues with EC's VIS led to some users to show up at the wrong polling stations or simply taking to social media to express their frustration at not knowing where to vote. In rare occasions, some users shared stories of poor access to polling stations for elderly and disabled electors.
- Lineups dominated online discussions related to voting in person on election day, leading many to conclude that Elections Canada was unprepared.

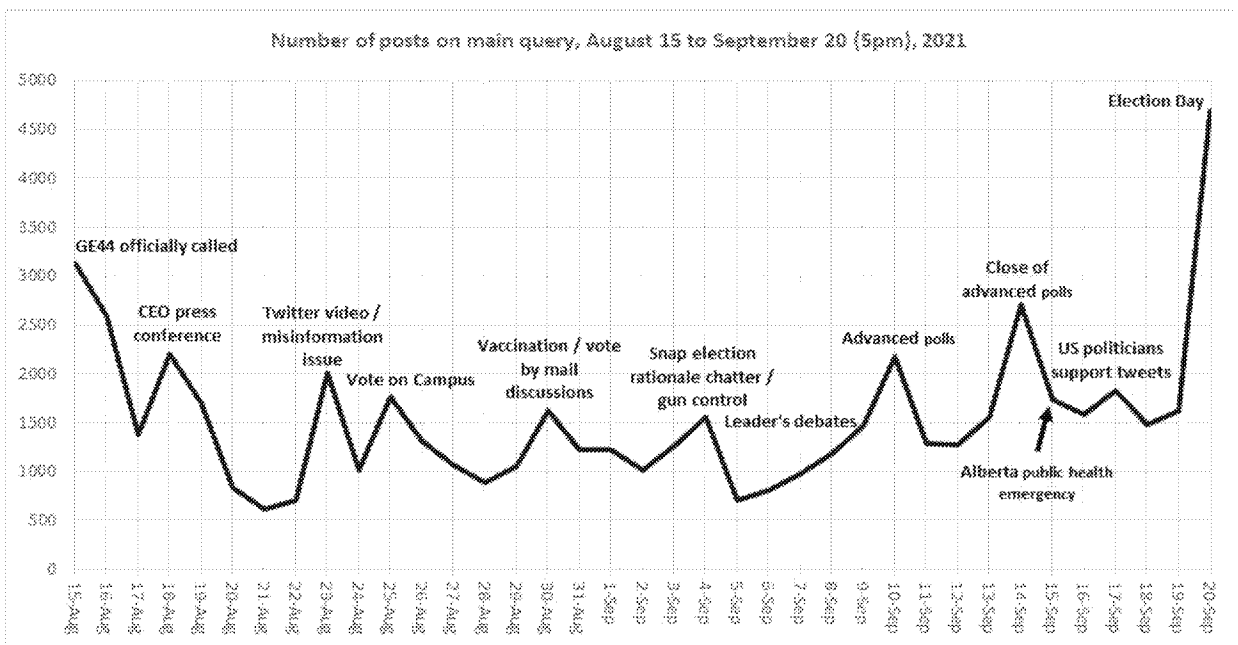
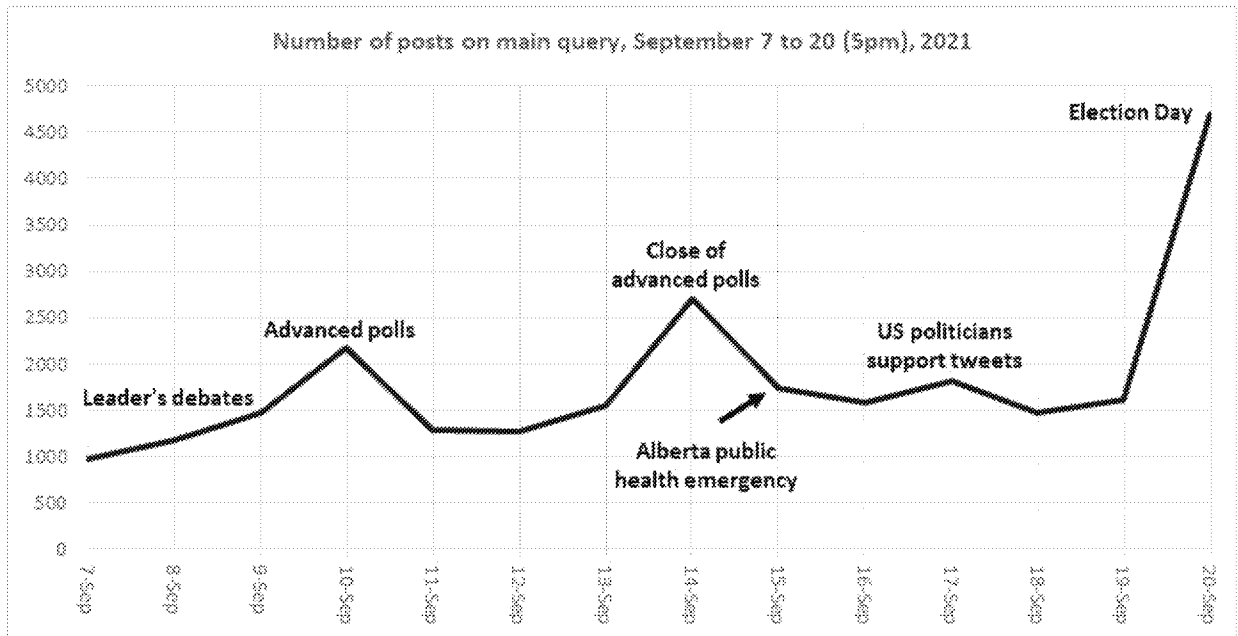

As much as it was the main topic for months before the election, the topic of vote by mail was not the leading one on Day 0. Very few posts mentioned this issue after September 19. Most of what the team identified was found on this topic was in comments sections and was focused on very well-known narratives including that special ballots would turn the tide of the election through fraud. The team found significantly fewer mentions of delays in results, likely due to the in-person voting dominating the public discourse. Early in the day, several users were still wondering what to do if they did not yet receive their special ballot kit and if they would be allowed to vote. We still observed rare mentions of dead voters. We expect this topic to come back in the upcoming days as special ballots get counted and official results gets published. Mentions of DVS, while a minor narrative, are still found in the environment, usually as a tool to discredit the electoral process and the upcoming results.

Lineups dominated the online discussion of voting in person on election day, starting with issues with polling places opening on time, then growing in prominence through the morning, lunch, post work, and finally late-night rushes. News coverage highlighted this somewhat unfamiliar, if not unexpected, aspect of voting in person in Canada. The issue of lineups was most prominent in Toronto where the total number of polls was most reduced, while Alberta dominated in terms of frictions at the polls due to masking policies of polling places. The general consensus was that while lineups are normally viewed as rare and a sign of interest in democracy in Canada, this election was different – lineups instead were interpreted by users as a failure to anticipate increased needs due to pandemic measures. Conversely, measures to facilitate safe and organized voting in person were viewed as barriers for voters that may discourage turnout.

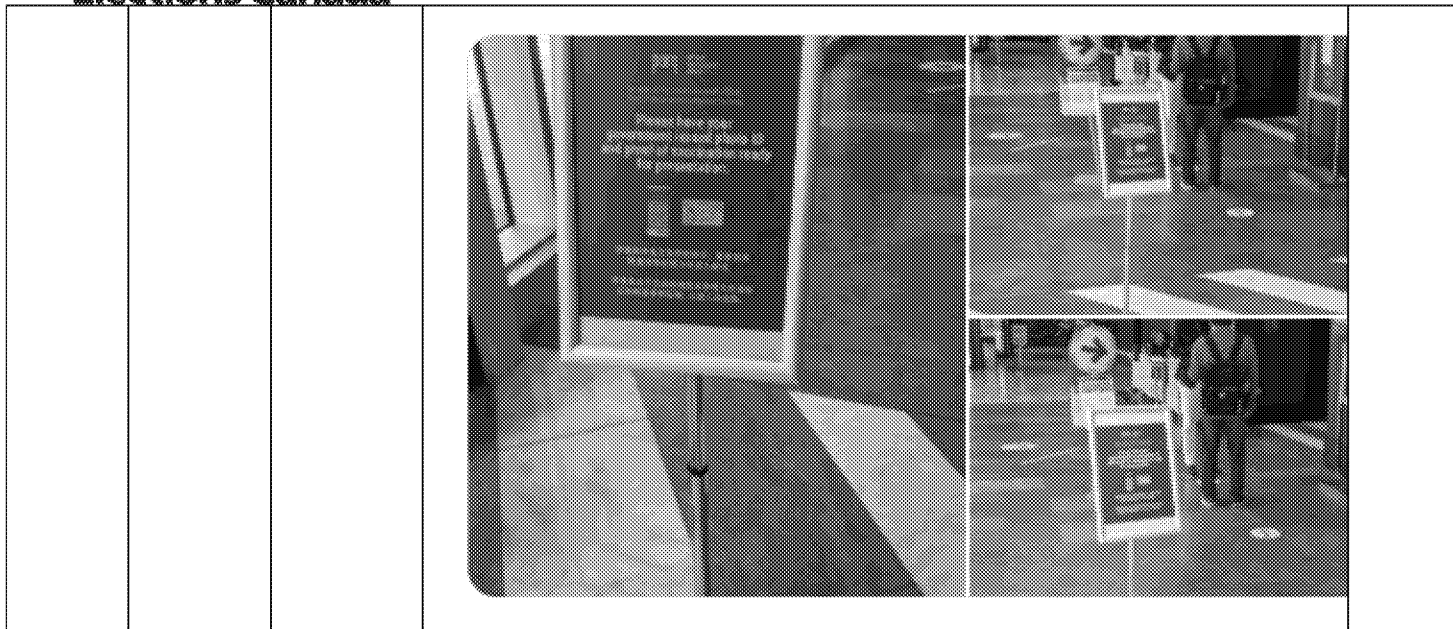

While the main issue of the evening was lineups at the polling places, other accessibility issues were observed throughout Election Day. The most important was VIS being down early in the day, and then down again around noon. This led to strong reactions from many users who questioned EC's lack of preparation and poor infrastructure. In some rarer cases, electors saw in these signs of electoral fraud, using for example the expression "stop the steal," associated with the 2020 US presidential election. Additionally, some users reported issues with VIS sending them at the wrong polling station and being turned back, sometimes after waiting in line for some time. This led to some confrontations with poll workers and users expressing frustration over the misleading information provided by EC. Finally, a few users shared stories of difficulties accessing polling places, including concerns for elderly and disabled voters.

Many electors who participated in GE44 went to the polls suspecting or even believing they were participating in a rigged system that was systematically designed to diminish their democratic power. This belief has been increasingly aired alongside anti-vaccine, anti-mask, and anti-lockdown sentiments that are entrenched in a distrust of government and institutions. Through this lens, any irregularities or misinterpreted messages from Elections Canada became red flags signaling a corrupt institution.
