

Supplementary Information to Statement of Anticipated Evidence of Han Dong

1. In the course of preparing to appear as a witness and reviewing his Statement of Anticipated Evidence for accuracy, Mr. Dong was reminded by his wife Sophia Qiao, who worked on his campaign, that students from a private high school voted in the 2019 nomination contest in Don Valley North. He believes that the students lived in a residence at Seneca College and recalls that they spoke Mandarin. As a result, he believes that they were likely mostly Chinese. He recalls being told that a bus organized by the school had transported some students who had registered as members of the Liberal party to the nomination meeting. He does not know whether all those students voted for him, but believes it is likely most did because he visited the school as part of his nomination campaign and encouraged students to support his candidacy by volunteering and/or registering as Liberal party members if they were eligible.
2. With respect to paragraph 6 of the Statement of Anticipated Evidence regarding Mr. Dong's first meeting with Michael Chan, he believes he briefly met Mr. Chan at an event sometime before he was asked to work on Mr. Chan's byelection campaign in 2007.
3. With respect to paragraph 17 of the Statement of Anticipated Evidence regarding transportation to the nomination meeting arranged by Mr. Dong's campaign, Mr. Dong now believes that his campaign rented two buses.
