In establishing the Public Inquiry into Foreign Interference ("PIFI" or the "Inquiry"), Order in Council P.C. 2023-0882 (the "OIC") set parameters for participants in the Inquiry.

Canada is a unique participant in the Inquiry by virtue of its role in national security and as the custodian of relevant records, including classified material. Its unique position as it relates to the subject matter of the Inquiry is reflected in subparagraph (iii)(J) of the OIC, which directs the Commissioner to "provide the Government of Canada with an opportunity to fully participate in the Public Inquiry."

In contemplation of other parties seeking to participate, the OIC authorizes the Commissioner to, in her discretion, grant participatory rights in the public portions of the Inquiry to any person she determines would both provide "appropriate and necessary" contributions to, and has a "substantial and direct interest" in, the Inquiry's subject matter. Canada also meets this threshold for participation, as discussed below.

- i) Substantial and Direct Interest in the Subject Matter of the Inquiry Canada is uniquely situated to participate in the Inquiry. Several federal government departments and agencies were integrally involved in the subject matter listed at subparagraphs (i)(A)-(D) of the OIC. Because these government departments and agencies, Canada has a substantial and direct interest in the subject matter of the Inquiry.
- ii) Necessary Contributions to the Inquiry Canada's full participation will provide appropriate and necessary contributions to the Inquiry. Canada is a primary source for information on all subject areas of the Inquiry, including classified material, as set out in the OIC. Canada will also be directly impacted by PIFI's findings and recommendations. It is necessary for Canada to have full participatory rights for PIFI to fulfill its mandate.
- iii) Contributions to the Openness and Fairness of the Inquiry
 As one of the primary sources of information germane to PIFI's mandate, openness and
 fairness of the Inquiry requires that Canada be granted full participatory rights. Federal
 departments and agencies are the custodians of key relevant material, including
 classified records. Canada is in a unique position to help the Commissioner balance the
 desire for transparency in a public inquiry and the need to protect classified information.
